


CLOUDS



Clouds are condensed water vapors in the atmosphere. Clouds form when tiny drops of water and ice join together in the sky.

CUMULUS CLOUDS



White puffy clouds that look like they are piled up on top of each other. These are a sign of good or fair weather.

STRATUS CLOUDS




Clouds that look like a huge gray blanket that lay low in the sky. They usually mean rain is coming!

CIRRUS CLOUDS



Clouds that are thin and wispy looking, almost like someone pulled them apart. When you see these clouds, it means the weather might change soon.

CUMULONIMBUS CLOUDS



Thick, gray clouds that usually have rain or snow falling out of them. They signal that it's time to get inside quick!
